Job Summary

The Senior CAD Designer assists with all of the design duties associated with assigned packaging and production systems and/or automated manufacturing equipment.

The Senior CAD Designer's duties will include, but not be limited to the following:

- Adherence to National Electric Code (NEC).
- Developing and implementing design standards.
- Drafting electrical drawings for power distribution, lighting plans, control panel fabrication & schematics, conduit and conductor plans and schedules.
- Drawing flow diagrams.
- Preparing parts and inventory lists.
- Designing dimension verification and maintaining drawing files.

Characteristics

The Senior CAD Designer must have good personal habits, work well with others, be technically conscientious, be able to stay on task and complete work on schedule, be able to work independently as well as on a team, and promote the principles and professionalism of Polytron and its various Alliance Partners.

Education

College diploma or certificate is highly desired. High school graduate or GED with technical schooling in computer-aided design (CAD) is a minimum requirement. Educational requirements may be waived if person has significant experience in the required areas.

Experience

Seven (7) years of experience in CAD, specifically AutoCAD electrical, or manual drafting; electrical, lighting or schematic drafting preferred. Familiarity with various mechanical/electrical packaging technology and equipment in the food, consumer goods, beverage, or factory automation industries preferred.

Other Skills

Must be organized. Must have good written and oral communication skills. Must manage multiple projects with minimal supervision.
